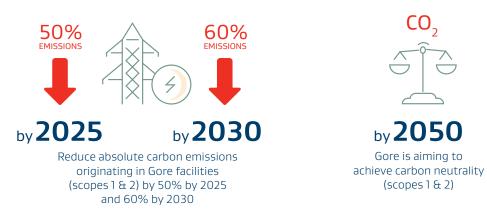


# ENVIRONMENT — MINIMIZING OUR IMPACT ON THE PLANET

At Gore, we have set ambitious goals to care for our planet in line with the Paris Agreement and Goal 13 of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

We adhere to a science-based approach to reduce our greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, and we follow the GHG Protocol — the world's most widely used GHG accounting standards — to calculate our emissions.

#### Working towards reducing absolute carbon emissions



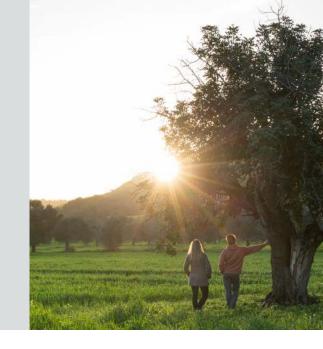
Reducing energy consumption is as essential as the share of renewable energy we use to achieve these goals. We aim to increase our use of renewable energy in all Gore manufacturing facilities to 100% by 2025. In our Arizona medical plants, we already use 100% renewable electricity.

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### Environmental management at-a-glance

- We're extending life cycle assessment (LCA) capabilities across the enterprise to measure the environmental impact of a product's entire life cycle, enabling us to focus our sustainability efforts where they matter most — informing product and process design.
- We are committed to obtaining International Organization for Standardization (ISO) 14001\* certification for our medical plants beginning in FY25.
- We're working to manage waste responsibly by implementing proper wastehandling and recycling processes in our Arizona plants. As the single-largest contributor to the KIMBERLY-CLARK RIGHTCYCLE Program, we diverted 42 tons of nitrile glove personal protective equipment (PPE) waste from landfills in 2022.

#### Supplier due diligence and diversity

Our corporate supplier code of conduct, covering ethical practices, human rights, legal requirements and environmental management, is rolled out to all our suppliers identified to be higher risk in our assessments. By working with more LGBTQ-, minority-, women- and veteran-owned suppliers, as well as businesses owned by persons with a disability, we broaden our pool of outstanding suppliers and position ourselves to meet growing customer demand.

#### Environmental, occupational safety and health management system

Our Environmental and Occupational Safety and Health (EOSH) policy sets forth key standards for environmental health and safety, including water protection and waste management, across all our operational areas. We are committed to obtaining International Organization for Standardization (ISO) 45001<sup>+</sup> certification for our medical plants.

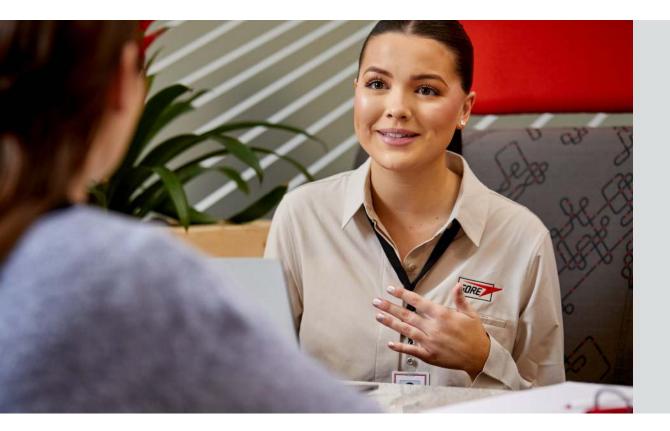
### Social impact at-a-glance
